EUROPEAN YOUTH PARLIAMENT REGIONAL SELECTION CONFERENCE MALLORCA 2024

From Friday 9th to Sunday 11th February, six GVS students participated in the Regional Selection Conference organised by the European Youth Parliament. Several schools from the Balearic Islands took part in this vibrant event which is a perfect combination of hard academic work and fun team-building activities. This year, the problems to be discussed and solved ranged from overfishing to gender discrimination through the so-called "period poverty", to implementation of the Universal Basic Income, among others.

The culmination of the three-day conference was the General Assembly at the Terra i Mar Theatre in Palma, where the delegates presented and debated the resolutions prepared in their committees.

Throughout the event delegates are closely monitored and the jury's final selection is based on various criteria, such as motivation and participation, evolution and personal development, open-mindedness and co-operation, communication skills and academics and sociopolitical awareness.

GVS was represented by Fee Sauer (Y10), Klara Kuntze (Y11), Soma Hagedorn (Y11), Elizaveta Gritsenko (Y12), Ilan Kuhne (Y12) and Simon Oertenholm (Y12). We are very proud to announce that Ilan has been selected as one of five students to represent the Balearic Islands at the National EYP Session in Valencia.

They showed they are ready to step out of their comfort zone in order to grow as persons, become more aware of their role in today's Europe, meet new friends and develop new skills.
